

From newel post to hand rail, each component is hand-finished with the utmost care and attention to detail. Next, our team of French polishers sand and lacquer the timber four times to create a smooth, luxurious feel.



A

lthough it appears to defy gravity, this cantilevered staircase is, of course, supported, albeit in a way that conceals all the fixings. This design comprises independent steps which are anchored to a bearing wall or stringer beam embedded in the wall, with the help of steel pins and bolts. For anyone wishing to transform a dark hallway and maximise available daylight, the cantilevered staircase is a great design option.







From the traditional to the avant garde (the sky really is the limit) our glasswork can transform the smallest of spaces.





FRAMELESS INFINITY STRUCTURAL glass can support the relevant loading without the requirement for posts and uses cleverly crafted stainless steel bolts instead, as seen in this new staircase design.

THE PROCESS

Making the decision to invest in a new staircase or renovate your existing one is an important one, which is why we believe in the personal touch from day one. First, we'll gather some information over the phone so we can get an idea of what you have in mind. We'll then arrange for one of our designers to come and visit you. This gives us the opportunity to discuss your ideas in more detail, look at the space we have to work with and chat through options available to you. We'll show you samples of our products so that you can get a sense of what your new staircase could look like. We'll also show you a portfolio of some of our work, to assist in the design process.



TAKING THE FIRST STEP

Whether you have a yen for seamless glass, wrought iron spindles or even powder coated steel in a particular shade of rose gold, we'll do our best to bring your vision to life. However, we recognise that sometimes people's perception of design and price are not always cohesive. This is why we often float a few designs and prices to our clients so they work within budget, design and lifestyle. Whether you have a moderate budget or an unlimited one, every client gets the same bespoke, considered service.

After our initial meeting, we'll send you some thoughts, designs and quotes via email for your perusal. Each price provided is accurate. We don't offer discounts as your staircase is tailor-made. It's therefore not a sale item or end of line product. We believe this approach reflects our company values.




THE SURVEY

Once you are comfortable with the design, we will arrange for one of our surveyors to visit your property to reconfirm each design detail and answer any questions. During this part of the journey, the surveyor will take detailed, pin-point accurate measurements which will then be passed on to the technical designers, who will create a variety of 2D and 3D drawings and images.

THE CREATION PROCESS

The workshop team will carefully prepare all the staircase components using the technical drawings to ensure accuracy. All team members work very closely together throughout this process because cohesive understanding is vital at this stage of the staircase journey. Before your staircase leaves our workshop, each element is quality controlled then carefully wrapped in preparation for delivery. We will contact you to reconfirm the date of installation and discuss final preparations.






THE INSTALLATION PROCESS

When our team arrives at your home, a canopy will be set up outside the working area because we pride ourselves on our efficient, neat working practices. We do ask that you are at home throughout the process so communication remains open between you and the team.

Once we have completed the work, we'll ask you to carry out an inspection along with our team to make sure you're happy with everything. We'll also give you a bespoke, aftercare kit to help ensure your staircase retains its premium finish. Once the 10 year guarantee is posted to you, our work is complete! That said, we are only ever a phone call away should you need to talk to us.

“ WE’RE GOOD AT WHAT WE DO BECAUSE WE LOVE WHAT WE DO

Frustrated with the increasingly modular approach to staircase design, Master Carpenter Jarrod Matthews and his wife Sherelle created Jarrods. We caught up with the husband and wife design duo to find out more about the company and its design philosophy

How did Jarrods come to be?

Jarrod: From a shared passion of design, a love of wood and a flare for creativity. We both strive for excellence and saw a great opportunity to start up our own business.

Sherelle: We often refer to staircases as the ‘forgotten room’ in that people will spend a great deal of time on bedrooms, kitchens and studies, but forget about the staircase. We’re giving this structural piece of furniture the opportunity to be the focal point of the home.

How would you like to change people’s thinking when it comes to staircases?

S: We want people to appreciate how important they are, and not overlook them. Not just from a design

point of view, but from an emotional one too. We have four children and a dog, and as soon as I open the door, the staircase is the first thing I see. The dog sits on the bottom step, waiting to be greeted, and my eyes wander to the items draped over the newel post, which allows me to determine which family members are already home. I’ve also been known to take to the stairs to make a phone call as it is a quieter space than the office or kitchen.

J: Our family likes to congregate on the stairs and sometimes have impromptu conversations there!

So is the staircase making a comeback?

S: I think it’s more about people having a lightbulb

moment as they realise what an important part of their home the staircase is. Once you start looking at the staircase with fresh eyes, you begin to see what an exciting, inspiring space it really is.

J: The hallway is as much a space as any room, and the staircase needs to work with that space, not block it. Some staircases have been ‘plonked’ in a hallway, with no thought to aesthetics or space. We want to create beautiful staircases that work with the building, complementing the existing architecture, and working with the lines and the space.

So you can ‘think big’ even if you only have a small space?

S: Absolutely. We’ve crafted beautiful works of art in the smallest of spaces. But because we understand architecture, and are passionate about design, we can transform an existing staircase into something that’s beautiful and in keeping with your home.

J: Creating a feeling of space, even if there isn’t much there to begin with, is a challenge we relish. For example, if you want to create space and transform your hallway into a work of art, a ‘floating’ cantilevered staircase will make you feel like you’ve walked into a new home.

What about cost?

S: Budget needs to be a consideration, obviously, but that doesn’t mean it should be a constraint. For us, it doesn’t

matter if you’ve got £4,000 or £40,000, you’ll get the same bespoke service and a beautiful staircase that will take pride of place.

What part of the creation process do you love most?

J: As a carpenter, I obviously love working with wood. Each piece is unique, and demands

something different from me as a carpenter. On a more practical level, one of the parts of the process I enjoy the most is getting to know our customers and their home and getting a feel for what would best suit their ideas, their home and their lifestyle.

S: I love researching the flexibility and diversity of materials that can be used in creating a very unique staircase. Coloured glass, rose gold bolts and engineered board, charcoal stained treads with cork faced risers. The possibilities are endless.

What considerations do you need to take into account?

J: There are literally hundreds of details to consider with even the most seemingly straightforward of projects. For example, are the walls even from top to bottom, or

does it taper or widen slightly? Is the floor completely flat or is there a tiny incline in one part? If the measurements aren’t precise, that causes a problem further down the line when we install the staircase.

S: In terms of considerations for anyone thinking about investing in a new staircase, or renovating an old one,

my advice is to look at your home with a fresh pair of eyes, and think about its personality. If you decide to work with us, our mutual goal would always be finding the perfect staircase for your space – one that suits your house, complementing its architecture and foundations, and your lifestyle. It also needs to be beautiful to look at, walk on and touch.

What trends can we look forward to in the world staircase design?

J: It’s not a trend *per se*, but what I’m excited about is that our clients are becoming increasingly brave and experimental, which suites in perfectly with our vision as a company. We love creating incredible pieces of work that are as much works of art as they are a necessity.

We are constantly experimenting with design and materials, and pushing the boundaries. For example, we recently went to Italy to source materials for our client, because they had something so specific in mind, and only that would do.

If you had a dream project, what would that be?

J: It’s always nice to be given free reign in terms of design and budget, but the really exciting projects are the challenging ones. For example, where someone has a narrow hallway but want you to make it look like it’s double the size, or when someone has a limited budget but an unlimited imagination. We love problem solving here, so challenges like that are great.

S: I enjoy it when our customers come to us with big, bold ideas for their staircase and task us to make them a reality. Or when they’ve been on a recent trip and been inspired by something they’ve seen, and want us to create something unique for them that brings that to life.

What’s next for Jarrods?

S: Because we’re innovators not followers, we’re always experimenting with materials and designs and ways to maximise space. From the functional to the ornate and sculptural, we’re always pushing the boundaries when it comes to staircase design. Anything is possible if you’ve got the right team behind you.
